



The Wellington Dog Park Members Information



The Dog Park is open Monday through Sunday from 8am to 8pm (or upon sunset in the winter).

Self Serve Dog Wash available: Our Muddy Mutt Wash is available during clinic business hours to clean your pet up after a fun playtime in the park. We provide shampoo, towels, and brushes for you to use. *Please inquire at the Front Desk for fees.*

The Wellington Dog Park is “PLAY AT YOUR OWN RISK”.

Dog Park Rules:

- Owners/Handlers are legally and financially responsible for any injuries caused by their dog and are advised to use the Dog Park at **THEIR OWN RISK**.
- Clean up and dispose of waste left by your dog. Bags and receptacles are provided.
- Aggressive dogs are not allowed. Dogs showing aggression toward people or other dogs must be removed from the park immediately.
- Members must wear a collar showing membership. All dogs must be fully immunized with tags and collars on at all times, to easily restrain them if necessary.
- Maximum of 2 dogs per owner/handler.
- Puppies under 4 months are prohibited. They are not sufficiently immunized.
- Dogs over 6 months should be spayed or neutered. No dogs in heat are allowed.
- Dogs must be on-leash when entering and exiting the park. Leashes are to be taken off in-between the two gates leading into the off leash area. Please close gate.
- Be courteous and respectful to new dogs and handlers entering the Dog Park by not congregating at the entrance. This is intimidating, and such gang behavior can create tension and spark conflict. Allow dogs entering the Dog Park time to acclimate.
- Accompany and supervise your dog at all times with quick access to a leash. The dog must be in visual and voice command at all times. Dogs may **NEVER** be left unattended under any circumstances.
- An adult must accompany children under 18. **ABSOLUTELY NO CHILDREN RUNNING.** The dog park is for off leash dogs and children may be at risk for serious injury.
- Alcohol, smoking, human food, and glass containers are strictly prohibited.
- Excessive barking is prohibited.
- Owners/Handlers must stop dogs from digging and immediately fill holes.
- The off-leash dog park is for dogs, their owners/handlers and others accompanying them. No other use is allowed.
- Professional dog trainers and/or groomers are not permitted to conduct their business on Wellington Veterinary Clinic Property.
- Wellington Veterinary Clinic reserves the right to revoke membership at any time.
